OVERVIEW

The Tbilisi Art Fair (TAF) is both a fair and a not-for-profit international contemporary art platform, created to broaden awareness and increase sales, mobility and cross border projects opportunities for the young and emerging art scenes from the wider Europe, with a focus on Georgia, the caucasus, central and eastern Europe. TAF provides collectors, institutions, art professionals and discerning art enthusiasts an exclusive, engaging and inclusive look at art scenes that are less easy to access, within a site specific art fair where participants can broaden their reach, deepen their relationships and exercise greater curatorial freedom with less financial strain and more emotional engagement. TAF bets on the talents and the genuine collectors, galleries and institutions who can support them and boost their career. In 2022, the average age of artists exhibited at TAF was less than 35 years old, and more than half were female.
